- **TRAINING PLATFORM - COMPREHENSIVE ONLINE PROGRAM ON GREEN AND SMART CITIES:** The Consortium has created a 30-hour online training program aimed at young people, youth workers, and trainers. This program is designed to provide a thorough understanding of green and smart cities.

- **ONGOING AND UPCOMING ACTIVITIES:** Partners are actively disseminating the training platform and trainers' manual developed within the project framework to civil society stakeholders, including municipalities and youth organizations, to gather feedback and promote the training. Following this, the Green Cities training module will undergo pilot testing with young participants.
